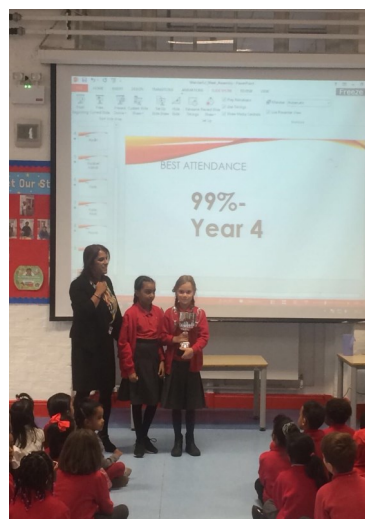
Role of our Family Support Worker - Mrs Ahmed

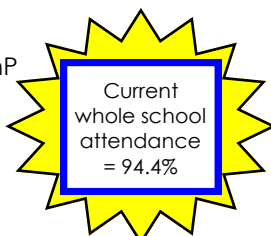
