Y6 British Museum Trip

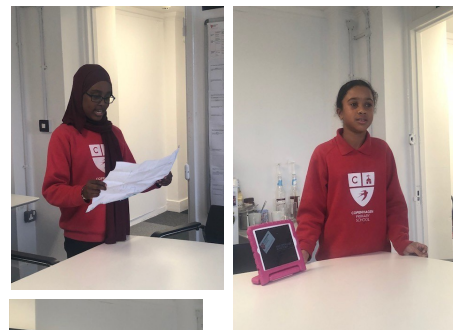

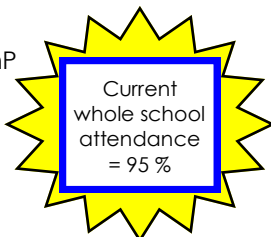
