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## Eye Heroes Workshop

Last week we had an Eye Heroes workshop for our Year 3 and 5 pupils. Eye Heroes come into schools and empower children to spread the word in their communities about the importance of eye health and regular eye checks.

The workshops are free and run by local volunteers from medical schools, teaching hospitals and other organisations.

The children participated in role play situations and learnt about how they could engage with their community to promote regular eye checks.



## Police Cadets

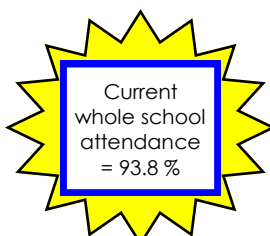
